WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2008

Audio/Video Editing

Participants are introduced to the theory and processes of audio/video production and editing using non-linear editing software. Production and post-production techniques are presented when attendees create and edit a short video for multiple applications.

AutoCAD

This introduction to the principles of the AutoCAD software demonstrates how the software relates to industry and demonstrates these commands: file, edit, element, settings, tool, draw, dimensioning and modify.

Highlights of Microsoft 2007

This session explores the new look and powerful new features of 2007 Microsoft Suite, focuses on Word, Excel, and PowerPoint and briefly examines Access. New terminology is covered while hands-on activities are completed. Participants should possess a working knowledge of earlier Microsoft Suite versions and know how to use a web browser such as Internet Explorer.

TUESDAY, JANUARY 20, 2009

Intro to Photoshop

This workshop will cover the basic operations of Photoshop and the tools involved.

Revit

This is an introduction to Revit, the architectural industry design-specific software. Participants insert basic construction objects to begin section elevations and designs for a commercial project. While intended for the novice drafter, some prior knowledge of 3-D drafting is helpful.

Non-Violent Crisis Intervention

This introduction to crisis prevention emphasizes the importance of early intervention and presents non-physical methods for preventing or managing disruptive behavior. Certification through CPI is included in this 8-hour workshop, running from 8:30 am - 4 pm.

FRIDAY, APRIL 17, 2009

ProENGINEER

The ProE workshop takes participants through the basic modeling of parts, then the assembly file of multiple parts. While creating drawing files, basic parts are dimensioned along with assembly representations.

InDesign

This workshop introduces InDesign, a page authoring and assembly program. Topics include Adobe InDesign tools and palettes, terminology and menus, as well as tips on creating and using images in InDesign.

Non-Violent Crisis Intervention

This introduction to crisis prevention emphasizes the importance of early intervention and presents non-physical methods for preventing or managing disruptive behavior. Certification through CPI is included in this 8-hour workshop, running from 8:30 am - 4 pm.

Technology in the Classroom with Powerpoint

This session explores the new features of PowerPoint 2007 and explains how to implement PowerPoint in the classroom.
